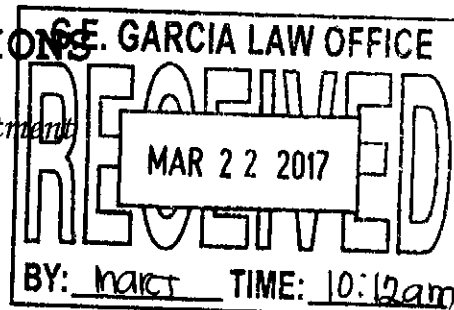

Dear **Hon. Sereno**:

This has reference to the Resolution dated March 7, 2017 of the Honorable Presidential Electoral Tribunal in P.E.T. Case No. 005 (*Ferdinand "Bongbong R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor "Leni Daang Matuwid" G. Robredo*), resolving, among others to:

(d) **NOTE** and **GRANT** the Ex-Parte motion for Leave to Secure Printed Copies of the Ballot Images, Audit Log Reports, Election Returns, and Other Pertinent Documents Relative to the Decryption of the Secure Digital Cards in Election Protest Case No. 16-007 dated February 22, 2017 filed by counsel for protestant Marcos, Jr., praying that the COMELEC Election Records and Statistics Department (ERSD) be directed to furnish protestant Marcos and/ or his authorized representative/s with printed copies of the ballot images, election returns, audit logs and other pertinent documents relative to the decryption of the SD cards in Election Protest Case No. 16-007 (*Carina Polinga vs. Sandy Ondis*);

(e) **DIRECT** the COMELEC ERSD to **FURNISH** protestant Marcos and/or his authorized representative/s with printed copies of the ballot images, election returns, audit logs and other pertinent documents relative to the decryption of the SD cards in Election Protest Case No. 16-007, subject to payment of appropriate fees;

A propos the above Resolution, please be advised that this office already conducted the decryption of SD cards, election returns and audit logs from February 15-18, 2017 per Order by the Regional Trial Court, Branch 63, Calabanga, Camarines Sur in EPC No. 16-008 and the documents/results pertaining to said case were already turned over to the RTC Clerk of Court of Branch 42.

In this regard, it is hereby suggested that the request of protestant Marcos Jr., be addressed directly to the RTC, considering that the said Court has in possession of the decrypted files (ballot images, election returns, audit logs and statistical data) since the same were already deleted from our files.

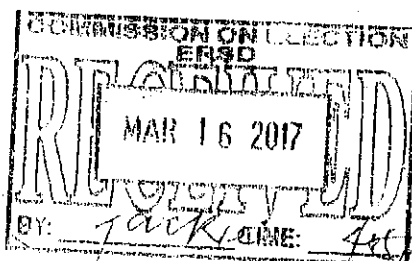
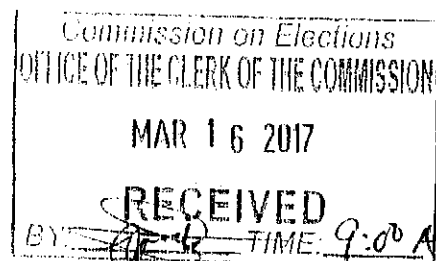

Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated **MARCH 7, 2017**, which reads as follows:

"P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand 'Bongbong' R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor 'Leni Daang Matuwid' G. Robredo).- Acting on the Motion for Reconsideration *Pro Tanto* (of the resolution dated January 24, 2017) with Prayer to Set for Hearing dated February 24, 2017 filed by counsel for protestee Maria Leonor G. Robredo, the Tribunal Resolved to require protestant Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr. to **COMMENT** thereon within a **NON-EXTENDIBLE** period of ten (10) days from notice hereof.

The Tribunal further Resolved to

- (a) **NOTE** the Order dated February 28, 2017 issued by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) Second Division in EPC No. 2016-07 (Ma. Risa Rafols Angara vs. Arlene Espinosa Zambo, et al.);
- (b) **NOTE** and **GRANT** the Motion for Clarification (Re: Resolution dated November 8, 2016), dated February 28, 2017 filed by the Office of the Solicitor General for the COMELEC, praying for the Tribunal to clarify the resolution dated November 8, 2016 and declare that the COMELEC is authorized to conduct backing up activities on the CCS laptops of all municipalities, cities, and provinces covered by the Precautionary Protection Order (PPO);
- (c) **CLARIFY** that the resolution dated November 8, 2016 likewise authorized the COMELEC to conduct backing-up activities of the CCS laptops of all municipalities, cities, and provinces covered by the PPO;
- (d) **NOTE** and **GRANT** the *Ex-Parte* Motion for Leave to Secure Printed Copies of the Ballot Images, Audit Log Reports, Election Returns, and Other Pertinent Documents Relative to the Decryption of the Secure Digital Cards in Election Protest Case No. 16-007 dated February 22, 2017 filed by counsel for protestant Marcos, Jr., praying that the COMELEC Election Records and Statistics Department
