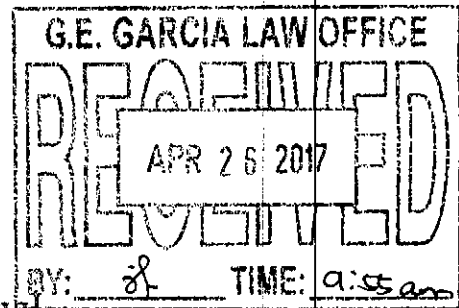

Sirs/Mesdames:

Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated APRIL 18, 2017, which reads as follows:

"P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand 'Bongbong' R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor 'Leni Daang Matuwid' G. Robredo).- The Tribunal Resolved to

(a) **NOTE** the Manifestation dated April 7, 2017 filed by counsel for protestee Maria Leonor G. Robredo, stating that on March 31, 2017, the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) suspended the stripping of the used Consolidated Canvassing System (CCS) as the certificates installed in the CCS USB tokens expired last December 2016; and that, while protestee Robredo has no objection to the backing up of the CCS, she would still like to seek clarification from the COMELEC on the following matters:

(i) Why do the certificates in the USB tokens expire;

(ii) How much is being spent by the COMELEC on the rent of the warehouse in Sta. Rosa, Laguna which is still being used for purposes of the closure activities;

(iii) Aside from the change in the date, will the other data contained in the CCS laptops be affected; and

(iv) Considering that the CCS laptops will not be turned over to Smartmatic but will be used by the COMELEC, what is the timetable for such intended use;

(b) **DIRECT** the COMELEC to **CLARIFY** the above-enumerated matters within ten (10) days from notice hereof;

(c) **NOTE** the Letter dated April 7, 2017 of Eden G. Chan, Information Systems and Judicial Records, Presidential

Electoral Tribunal (PET), and Gary Louie S. Comia, Systems Development for Judicial Application Division, Management Information Systems Office, submitting their Observation Report on the closure, stripping and backing up of Vote Counting Machines (VCM) and CCS Kits conducted by the COMELEC on March 20, 2017, March 27, 2017 and April 3, 2017 at the JAMS Liner Warehouse, Sta. Rosa, Laguna; and
