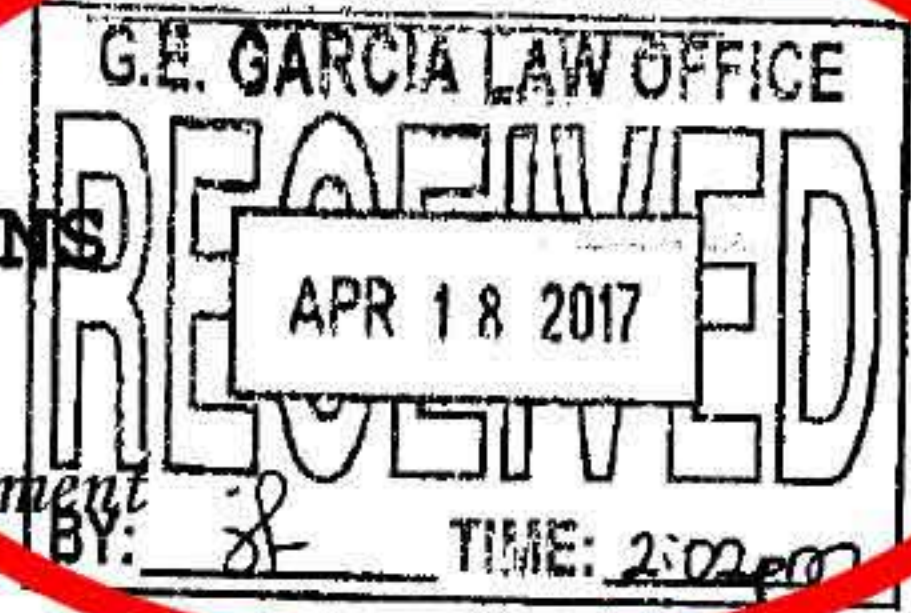

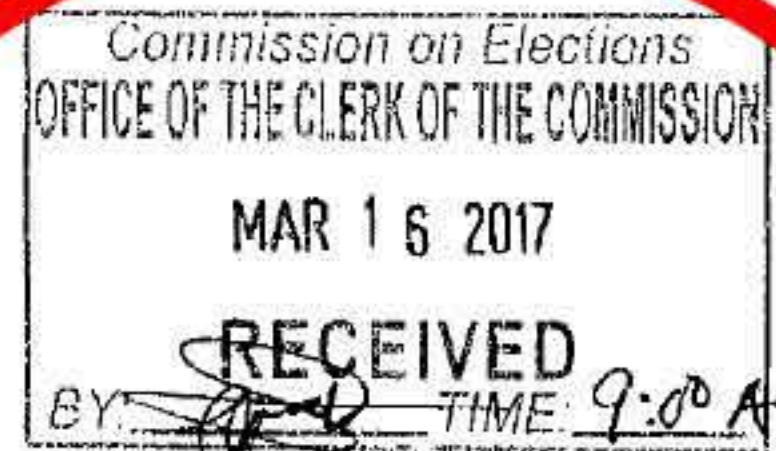

Sirs/Mesdames:

Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated **MARCH 7, 2017**, which reads as follows:

"P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand 'Bongbong' R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor 'Leni Daang Matuwid' G. Robredo).- Acting on the Motion for Reconsideration *Pro Tanto* (of the resolution dated January 24, 2017) with Prayer to Set for Hearing dated February 24, 2017 filed by counsel for protestee Maria Leonor G. Robredo, the Tribunal Resolved to require protestant Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr. to **COMMENT** thereon within a **NON-EXTENDIBLE** period of ten (10) days from notice hereof.

The Tribunal further Resolved to

(a) **NOTE** the Order dated February 28, 2017 issued by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) Second Division in EPC No. 2016-07 (Ma. Risa Rafols Angara vs. Arlene Espinosa Zambo, et al.);

(b) **NOTE** and **GRANT** the Motion for Clarification (Re: Resolution dated November 8, 2016), dated February 28, 2017 filed by the Office of the Solicitor General for the COMELEC, praying for the Tribunal to clarify the resolution dated November 8, 2016 and declare that the COMELEC is authorized to conduct backing-up activities on the CCS laptops of all municipalities, cities, and provinces covered by the Precautionary Protection Order (PPO);

(c) **CLARIFY** that the resolution dated November 8, 2016 likewise authorized the COMELEC to conduct backing-up activities of the CCS laptops of all municipalities, cities, and provinces covered by the PPO;

(d) **NOTE** and **GRANT** the *Ex-Parte* Motion for Leave to Secure Printed Copies of the Ballot Images, Audit Log Reports, Election Returns, and Other Pertinent Documents Relative to the Decryption of the Secure Digital Cards in Election Protest Case No. 16-007 dated February 22, 2017 filed by counsel for protestant Marcos, Jr., praying that the COMELEC Election Records and Statistics Department

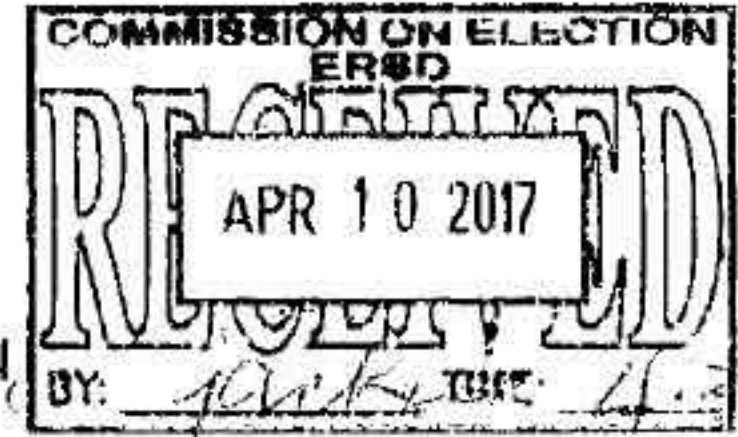

ORDER

This Court is in receipt on April 4, 2017 of the Resolution dated March 7, 2017 issued by the Presidential Electoral Tribunal in PET Case No. 005 (*Ferdinand "Bongbong" R. Marcos, Jr. vs Maria Leonor "Leni Daang Matuwid" G. Robredo*), granting and authorizing this Court's request for the Commission on Election's Election Records and Statistics Department (COMELEC ESRD) to decrypt the SD cards and print the digital ballot images, election returns and audited logs for the seven (7) protested clustered precincts during the May 9, 2016 local election in the Municipality of Araceli, Palawan.

In view thereof, it is hereby requested from the ESRD that the SD cards decryption and printing of the aforementioned documents pertinent to this election contest, which is docketed thereat as EPC Case No. 16-008, be conducted on April 26, 2017 at the Project Management Office of the Commission, Ground Floor, Palacio del Gobernador, Intramuros, Manila. The parties are hereby notified of said schedule and directed to send their respective representatives thereat, preferably members of the constituted revision committee, at their own expenses.

The chairperson of the revision committee, Ms. Beverly Z. Belandres, Court Interpreter, is likewise authorized to be the representative of this Court to observe the decryption process and to receive the documents and reports from ESRD. Upon the conclusion of the decryption, she is hereby directed to submit a report thereof within three (3) days from return to office.

Protestant, as the requesting party, is likewise directed to comply with ESRD's Order of Payment dated March 20, 2017, and to pay other incidental expenses that may arise during said decryption. Further, she is ordered to shoulder the transportation, meal and lodging expenses of this Court's representative during said decryption.
