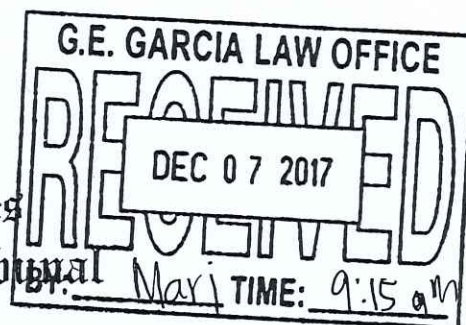

Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated NOVEMBER 28, 2017, which reads as follows:

“P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor ‘Leni Daang Matuwid’ G. Robredo).- The Tribunal Resolved to

(a) **NOTE** the Manifestation and Comment (on the Manifestation and Compliance [Re: List of Witnesses for the Third Cause of Action] dated October 9, 2017), dated November 21, 2017 filed by counsel for protestee Maria Leonor G. Robredo;


(b) **NOTE** the Letter dated November 22, 2017 of Atty. Michael L. Garcia, Acting Clerk, Second Division, Commission on Elections (COMELEC), in connection with EAC No. 21-2017 (Sahi L. Jainal vs. Nasser A. Abubakar) pending before the COMELEC (Second Division) which is an appeal from the Decision dated July 31, 2017 of the Regional Trial Court (RTC), Branch 1, Isabela City, Basilan in Election Protest Case No. 02-16 (Sahi L. Jainal vs. Nasser A. Abubakar), stating, among others, that there is no record that would show that the court of origin obtained prior authority from the Tribunal with respect to the possession and custody of the ballot boxes, election documents and related paraphernalia and the revision of ballots in Election Protest Case No. 02-16; and **GRANT** the request of the COMELEC Second Division to continue with the proceedings in the aforesaid EAC No. 21-2017 pending before it; and

(c) **NOTE** the Letter dated November 17, 2017 of Atty. Garcia in connection with EAC No. 13-2017 (Romero S. Daoaten vs. Rosalina C. Biscarra) pending before the COMELEC (Second Division) which is an appeal from the Decision dated May 17, 2017 of the RTC, Branch 58, Bucay, Abra in Election Case No. 16-91 (Romero S.
