*Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated **JANUARY 16, 2018**, which reads as follows:*

**“P.E.T. Case No. 005** (Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor ‘Leni Daang Matuwid’ G. Robredo).- The Tribunal Resolved to **NOTE WITHOUT ACTION** the

(a) Motion to Reiterate Turnover of the Official, Printed and Authenticated Copies of the Decrypted Ballot Images, Election Returns and Audit Logs to the Protestant dated January 8, 2018 filed by counsel for protestant Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr., in view of the resolution dated January 10, 2018; and

(b) Letter dated January 10, 2018 of Analiza E. Mendiola, City Treasurer, Office of the City Treasurer, City of Caloocan, requesting authority to transfer the white ballot boxes being kept in the Bulwagang Katipunan, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Old City Hall Building, A. Mabini Street, Caloocan City, to the COMELEC South, 1/F CIBU Building, 1474 A. Mabini Street, Caloocan City, in view of the lifting of the Precautionary Protection Order issued in this protest.

Acting on the Supplemental Retrieval Team Report dated January 16, 2018 filed by Atty. Linuel G. Alindogan, Court Attorney IV, Office of the Chief Attorney and Retrieval Team Leader, Presidential Electoral Tribunal (PET), the Tribunal Resolved to

(a) **AUTHORIZE** the Retrieval Team to

(i) Augment the PET personnel by hiring twenty (20) local field handlers with their compensations based on the minimum wage prevailing in the area as provided by law;

(ii) Charter a bus for the use of the PET, Philippine National Police and Supreme Court Security personnel as their mode of transportation; and

(2) additional drivers, if necessary; and
