Sirs/Mesdames:

Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated **JANUARY 23, 2018**, which reads as follows:

“P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor ‘Leni Daang Matuwid’ G. Robredo).- The Tribunal Resolved to

(a) **NOTE** the Report dated January 16, 2018 of Atty. Linuel G. Alindogan, Court Attorney IV, Office of the Chief Attorney, and Retrieval Team Leader, indorsing the Report of Deputy Head of Security Joery L. Gayanan relative to the change in the duration of the retrieval period based on the recommendation and assessment of the Philippine National Police-Special Action Force (PNP-SAF) as to the security threat involved during the actual delivery of the ballot boxes from Camarines Sur to the Supreme Court (SC) Compound; and stating that the change is limited to the delivery to the SC Compound only and not to the scheduled days of delivery from the different municipalities and cities as stated in the resolution dated December 5, 2017;

(b) **NOTE** the Report dated January 19, 2018 of Atty. Alindogan, informing the Tribunal that, in the event that the Convention Center will be used by the Provincial Government of Camarines Sur for a provincial activity, they will be using the Sangguniang Panlalawigan Bulwagan, which is adjacent to or near the Convention Center, as alternative staging area; and that the duration of the retrieval period will be from January 23 to February 3, 2018 as required by the PNP-SAF;

(c) **DIRECT** the Process Servicing Unit to **RESEND** the resolution dated December 5, 2017, together with this resolution, to the

resolution dated December 5, 2017 addressed to City Treasurer Belleza at the aforesaid address was returned unserved with notation on the letter-envelope 'Moved Out'; and


(ii) Provincial Director, PNP-Quezon Province *vice* PSSupt. Eugenio B. Paguirigan, Quezon Police Provincial Office, Camp Nakar, 4301 Lucena City, it appearing from the records that the resolution dated December 5, 2017 addressed to PSSupt. Paguirigan, Provincial Director, PNP-Quezon Province, at the aforesaid address was returned unserved with notation on the letter-envelope 'Person Transfer (*sic*) Camp Crame'; and

(d) **NOTE** and **GRANT** the following letters:

(i) Letter dated January 16, 2018 of Atty. George Erwin M. Garcia, counsel for protestant Ferdinand 'Bongbong' R. Marcos, Jr., submitting the names of the individuals who will act as representatives of the protestant during the retrieval, collection, transport and delivery of the ballots to the SC Compound from January 23, 2018 until its completion; and requesting the issuance of the corresponding credentials for their proper guidance and authority to act as such; and

(ii) Letter dated January 16, 2018 of Atty. Maria Bernadette V. Sardillo, counsel for protestee Maria Leonor G. Robredo, submitting the names of their representatives to the scheduled retrieval and requesting that they be issued identification cards therefor. Caguioa and Martires, JJ., on leave. (1)
