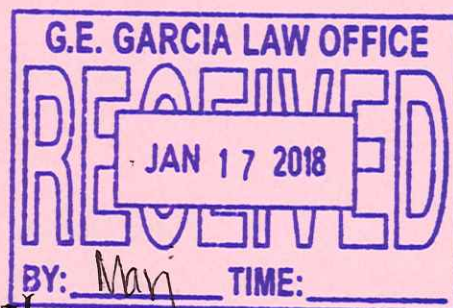

Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated JANUARY 10, 2018, which reads as follows:

“PET Case No. 005 - FERDINAND “BONGBONG” R. MARCOS, JR., protestant, versus MARIA LEONOR “LENI DAANG MATUWID” G. ROBREDO, protestee.

Acting on the Motion to Turnover to the Protestant the Official, Printed and Authenticated Copies of the Decrypted Ballot Images, Election Returns and Audit Logs dated November 17, 2017 filed by the counsel for protestant Ferdinand “Bongbong” R. Marcos, praying for this Tribunal to direct the Commission on Elections’ Election Records and Statistics Department (COMELEC-ERSD) to turn over to the protestant all the official printed and authenticated copies of the decrypted ballot images, election returns and audit logs for all the protested clustered precincts of the pilot provinces of Camarines Sur, Iloilo and Negros Oriental, the Tribunal Resolved to **ALLOW** protestant to secure photocopies or soft copies of the decrypted ballot images, election returns and other reports for all the protested clustered precincts of the pilot provinces, subject to the payment of incidental costs. However, the custody of the official, printed and authenticated copies of the decrypted ballot images, election returns and audit logs from the protested clustered precincts of the said pilot provinces should remain with the Tribunal for the conduct of the revision proceedings pursuant to the 2010 PET Rules.

The Tribunal further Resolved to:

- a. **DENY** the Partial Motion for Reconsideration (of the resolution dated November 7, 2017) dated December 4, 2017 filed by counsel for the protestant Ferdinand “Bongbong” R. Marcos, Jr. praying for the Tribunal to grant the partial reconsideration; reverse and reconsider the directive in resolution dated November 7, 2017 which granted protestee’s Urgent Ex-Parte Motion to be Allowed to Secure Soft Copies of the Ballot Images and Other Reports from the Decrypted Secured Digital Cards dated October 23, 2017 relative to the ongoing


decryption and printing of the ballot images, election returns and audit logs for all the protested clustered precincts of the pilot provinces of Camarines Sur, Iloilo, and Negros Oriental;

- b. **NOTE** the Letter dated December 19, 2017 from Atty. Michael L. Garcia, Acting Clerk of the COMELEC, in connection with EAC No. 25-2017 (*Bhenzar J. Yusoph vs. Darussalam S. Lajid*) pending before the COMELEC (Second Division), and **ALLOW** the COMELEC (Second Division) to continue with the proceedings in EAC No. 25-2017 subject to the employment of appropriate measures in preserving the integrity of the ballots and ballot boxes subject of the aforementioned case;
- c. **NOTE** the Letter dated December 23, 2017 from Atty. Bartolome J. Sinocruz, Jr., Deputy Executive Director for Operations, COMELEC and **GRANT** the request of Veronica B. Barrameda, City Treasurer, Tabaco City, for authority to transfer the storage area of ballot boxes and other election paraphernalia, including those used in the May 9, 2016 National and Local Elections, from its present location at the warehouse at the 4th Floor of the City Hall Annex Building, to the proposed IT Room, same floor and building, due to the on-going construction activities of the Multi-Purpose Hall Building by SANRHO Builders, Inc., subject to the following conditions: (i) that COMELEC shall give the Tribunal and the parties prior notice of the date of the transfer of the ballot boxes and all files pertaining to the May 9, 2016 National and Local Elections; and (ii) that the Tribunal and the parties shall be informed of the status and result of the foregoing activities;
- d. **NOTE** the Memorandum dated November 21, 2017 from Atty. Eden T. Candelaria, Acting Administrative Officer, re: Modification of the Position Title of the Coordinator in the Presidential Electoral Tribunal and Collapse of Position, **AMEND FURTHER** Rule 39(b) of A.M. No. 10-4-29-SC, re: *2010 Rules of the Presidential Electoral Tribunal* (2010 PET Rules) as amended by the Resolution of the Tribunal dated October 18, 2017 in P.E.T. Case No. 005 and **RENAME/RETITLE** the position of Coordinator as **HEAD REVISOR**; and **AMEND FURTHER** Rule 40 of the 2010 PET Rules, as amended by Resolution of the Tribunal in P.E.T Case No. 005, and **COLLAPSE** the position of Recorder and **ALLOCATE** the compensation thereof to the position of the Head Revisor. Hence, the compensation of the Head Revisor will be One Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Pesos (P1,260.00), per clustered precinct due to the enormity of the work that they will perform; and
- e. **NOTE** the Memorandum dated December 13, 2017 from Atty. Eden T. Candelaria, Chief Administrative Officer, Office of Administrative

Services (OAS), and **HIRE** One (1) Contractual Registered Psychometrician under Contract of Services with a monthly salary of Forty Thousand Pesos (P40,000.00) for an initial period of three (3) months subject to renewal, if necessary.” (1a)
