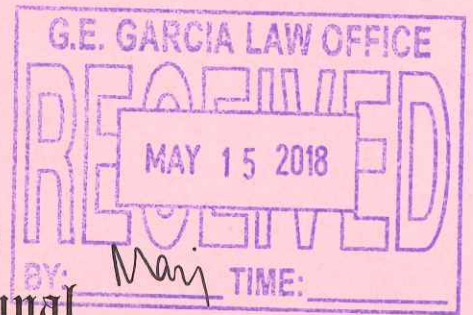

NOTICE

Sirs/Mesdames:

*Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated **APRIL 17, 2018**, which reads as follows:*

**“P.E.T. Case No. 005** (Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor ‘Leni Daang Matuwid’ G. Robredo).- Acting on the Manifestation and Motion dated April 5, 2018 filed by counsel for the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) relative to the Precautionary Protection Order on the Election Management System Servers, the Tribunal Resolved to **REQUIRE** the protestant and the protestee to **COMMENT** thereon within a **NON-EXTENDIBLE** period of ten (10) days from notice hereof.

The Tribunal further Resolved to

(a) **NOTE** the Letter dated March 15, 2018 of Atty. Jose M. Tolentino, Jr., Executive Director, COMELEC, relative to the request of Acting Election Officer Ferdinand T. Bermejo, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan and **GRANT** the said request of Acting Election Officer Bermejo to borrow the Book of Voters (Voter’s Registration Record and Election Day Computerized Voters List), currently in the custody of the Tribunal, for use in the verification proceedings in the recall petition against Vice-Mayor Luis M. Marcaida III, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan, subject to the condition that the verification is conducted within the premises of the Tribunal;

(b) **NOTE** the Letter dated March 27, 2018 filed by Atty. Rey D. Doma, Director III, Administrative Services Department, COMELEC, in compliance with the resolution dated March 6, 2018, specifying the list of boxes (canvassing kits) where Broadband Global Access Network (BGAN) units, GPRS modems and headphones may have been deposited after the conduct of the elections on May 9, 2016; and

(c) **GRANT** the request of the COMELEC that it be allowed to open the aforesaid ballot boxes to enable them to retrieve and recover the missing or unreturned BGAN units, GPRS modems and headphones which were consigned to the various Boards of Canvassers during the May 9, 2016 National and Local Elections.



Acting on the Memorandum dated April 12, 2018 of Atty. Ma. Carina M. Cunanan, Acting Assistant Administrative Officer and Vice Chairperson, *Ad Hoc* Committee, the Tribunal Resolved to **AUTHORIZE** the following:

(a) Conduct of the Revision Training Seminar by the PET *Ad Hoc* Committee last April 5, 2018 (from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) and April 6, 2018 (from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon) at the Public Information Office, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Supreme Court (SC)-Court of Appeals Building, Manila;

(b) Attendance of twenty-five (25) participants in the aforesaid Seminar;

(c) Use of necessary multi-media equipment from the Management Information System Office (MISO), SC and the attendance of one (1) MISO personnel as Assisting Technical Staff during the duration of the Seminar; and

(d) Expenditure of the total amount of Sixteen Thousand Nine Hundred Pesos (₱16,900.00), chargeable against the regular fund of the Tribunal, computed as follows:

(a) Hiring of the following individuals/applicants to the other contractual positions in the PET under contracts of 9




services, in connection with the present Vice-Presidential electoral protest, effective upon assumption to duty, for an initial period of six (6) months, subject to renewal if necessary:
