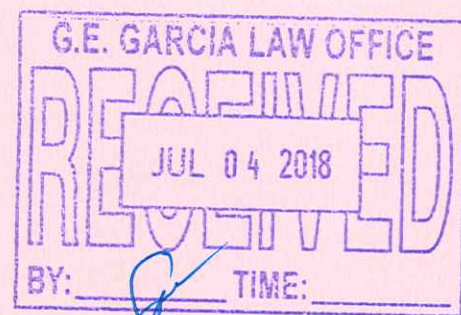

NOTICE

Sirs/Mesdames:

Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated JUNE 19, 2018, which reads as follows:

“P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor ‘Leni Daang Matuwid’ G. Robredo).- Acting on the Letter dated April 19, 2018 of Atty. Maria Bernadette V. Sardillo of Sardillo Sardillo Salom Law Office, counsel for protestee Maria Leonor G. Robredo, the Tribunal Resolved to

(a) **GRANT** counsel’s request that they be allowed to photocopy the ballots that have been considered as stray in the ongoing revision, recovery and re-appreciation of ballots, particularly the ballots containing the votes/voting marks in favor of their client;

(b) **DIRECT** the PET *Ad Hoc* Committee to **COORDINATE** with the parties on the procedure to be followed in photocopying the requested ballots; and

(c) **DIRECT** the protestant to **MANIFEST** whether he intends to make a similar request as that made by the protestee above.

The Tribunal further Resolved to

(a) **NOTE** the 1st Indorsement dated May 30, 2018 of Atty. Maria Victoria Gleoresty SP. Guerra, Officer-in-Charge, Public Information Office, referring the Email dated May 29, 2018 of Arnelfa Paliza;

(b) **NOTE WITHOUT ACTION** the aforesaid Email of Ms. Paliza, requesting that the Court, acting as the Presidential Electoral Tribunal, use the twenty-five percent (25%) threshold for the recount, as stated in the letter of the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) to the Clerk of the Tribunal last September 2017;

(c) **NOTE WITHOUT ACTION** the Letter dated May 30, 2018 of Alyssa Mary John P. Abanes, et al., representing one hundred thirty-two (132) law students in

Bicol, appealing to this Tribunal to implement the twenty-five percent (25%) threshold which was the rule adopted in the 2016 Elections;

(d) **NOTE** and **CONSIDER** as **COMPLIANCE** (with the resolution dated April 24, 2018) the Letter dated June 4, 2018 of Lea M. Duque, Municipal Treasurer, Municipality of Sagñay, Camarines Sur, submitting her explanation as to why the ballots referred to in Item (i), paragraphs 6, 7 and 8, and Item k of the resolution dated April 24, 2018 were wet or damaged;

(e) **NOTE** and **CONSIDER** as **COMPLIANCE** (with the resolution dated April 24, 2018) the Letter dated June 5, 2018 of Helen I. Priela, Municipal Treasurer, Municipality of Bato, Camarines Sur, submitting her explanation as to why the ballots referred to in Item (i), 1-5 and 11, of the resolution dated April 24, 2018 were wet or damaged;

(f) **NOTE WITHOUT ACTION** the Letter dated June 11, 2018 of AR Angcos, et al., Bantay Nakaw Coalition, expressing their support for the twenty-five percent (25%) threshold in the shading of ballots; and

(g) **GRANT** the Motion dated June 11, 2018 filed by the Office of the Solicitor General for the COMELEC for a second extension of fifteen (15) days from June 11, 2018, or until June 26, 2018, within which to file a comment on protestee Robredo's Urgent Motion for Reconsideration (of the resolution dated April 10, 2018) with Reiterative Prayer to Immediately Direct the Head Revisors to Use the Twenty-Five (25%) Threshold Percentage in the Revision, Recount and Re-Appreciation of Ballots dated April 18, 2018, with a **WARNING** that no further extension will be given by the Tribunal.

Acting on the following Incident Reports relative to the on-going revision of ballots, the Tribunal Resolved to

(i) **NOTE** the Incident Report (Re: Misplaced Election Receipt) dated May 25, 2018, which reads 'Election Receipt (ER) found under the table of RC#21. Head Revisor assigned to the table on May 24, 2018 said that the ER belonged to CP#46, Brgy. Patag-Belen, Caramoan, Camarines Sur. (Attachment: ER showing vote for President-Roxas, Mar Daang Matuwid ONLY)'; **DIRECT** the assigned Revision Supervisor to **CONFIRM** that the subject Election Receipt pertains to Clustered Precinct No. 46, Caramoan, Camarines Sur; if confirmed, **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for revised Clustered Precinct No. 46, Caramoan, Camarines Sur, to **RE-OPEN** the ballot box and **RETURN** the subject

Election Receipt; and **DIRECT** the assigned Revision Supervisors to **PREPARE** an Incident Report on the foregoing;

(ii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated May 25, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 36 (Precincts 0030A, 0030B), Brgy. Lupi, Tinambac, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 32, which reads '4 black zip ties used to seal ballot box instead of COMELEC red plastic seals (Serial Nos. 0249753, 0249754, 0249755, 0249756, and 0249757); plastic seals found inside the ballot box already wet; election return envelope not inside ballot box, cannot be found; envelopes for MOV and torn ballots appear to have been previously opened; and Voter's receipt box is missing; Voter's receipts found scattered inside ballot box'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for revised Clustered Precinct No. 36, Brgy. Lupi, Tinambac, Camarines Sur, to **CONTINUE** with the revision of paper ballots; and **DIRECT** the Municipal Treasurer of Tinambac, Camarines Sur, to **EXPLAIN** the observations in the subject Incident Report within ten (10) days from notice hereof;

(iii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated May 28, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 53 (Precincts 45A, 45B, 45C and 45D), Brgy. San Ramon, Tinambac, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 36, which reads 'the signature of the chairman of the BOI on the MOV, ER and different envelopes are all in full, whereas the signatures on the official ballots are all in initials (With different/questionable strokes)'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for revised Clustered Precinct No. 53, Tinambac, Camarines Sur, to **PROCEED** with the revision of paper ballots; and **DIRECT** the Revision Supervisors to **CONTINUE** with the revision of ballot boxes under similar circumstances;

(iv) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated May 28, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 54 (Precincts 46A, 46B and 46C), Brgy. San Roque, Tinambac, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 5, which reads 'wet and moldy ballots that are completely unreadable; red COMELEC seals were broken and found inside the ballot box'; and **APPROVE** the recommendation to 'revise ballot images';

(v) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated May 28, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 44 (Precincts 36A and 36B), Brgy. Olag Grande, Tinambac, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 38, which reads 'the signature of the Chairman of the MOV, ER and different envelopes are all in full, whereas the signature on official ballots are all in initials (with different/questionable strokes)'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for revised Clustered Precinct No. 44, Brgy. Olag Grande, Tinambac, Camarines Sur, to **PROCEED** with the revision of paper ballots; and **DIRECT** the Revision Supervisors to

CONTINUE with the revision of ballot boxes under similar circumstances;

(vi) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated May 28, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 51 (Precincts 0043A, 0043B, 0043C and 0043D), Brgy. San Antonio, Tinambac, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 29, which reads 'the signatures of the Chairman of BOI in the MOV, ER and different envelopes are all in full, whereas the signature on official ballots are all in initials (with different/questionable strokes)'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for revised Clustered Precinct No. 51, Brgy. San Antonio, Tinambac, Camarines Sur, to **PROCEED** with the revision of paper ballots; and **DIRECT** the Revision Supervisors to **CONTINUE** with the revision of ballot boxes under similar circumstances;

(vii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated May 28, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 59 (Precincts 0050G, 0050H, 0050I and 0050J), Brgy. Tambang, Tinambac, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 6, which reads 'the signature of the Chairman of BOI on the MOV, ER and other envelopes are all in full, whereas the signature on official ballots are all in initials (with no specimen signature/ no point of comparison on other documents.)'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for revised Clustered Precinct No. 59, Brgy. Tambang, Tinambac, Camarines Sur, to **PROCEED** with the revision of paper ballots; and **DIRECT** the Revision Supervisors to **CONTINUE** with the revision of ballot boxes under similar circumstances;

(viii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated May 28, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 61 (Precincts 0052B, 0052C, 0052D and 0052E), Brgy. Tierra Nevada, Tinambac, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 31, which reads 'There is an apparent discrepancy of the BEI chairman's signature appearing on the Official Ballots as compared to all the other documents inside the ballot box such as MOV, envelopes, election returns, etc. The signatures appearing on the official ballot seem to be just initials while on all the other documents it appears to be full signatures; there is no point of comparison to the other documents because the initials appeared only on the official ballots'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for revised Clustered Precinct No. 61, Brgy. Tierra Nevada, Tinambac, Camarines Sur, to **PROCEED** with the revision of paper ballots; and **DIRECT** the Revision Supervisors to **CONTINUE** with the revision of ballot boxes under similar circumstances;

(ix) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated May 29, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 24 (Precincts 0048C, 0049A, 0049B and 0050A), Brgy. Huyonhuyon, Tigaon, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 34, which reads 'Discrepancy of signatures in

official ballots and ER; signatures in MOV, ER and other documents are complete; whereas the official ballots were signed only with initials bearing different strokes'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for revised Clustered Precinct No. 24, Brgy. Huyonhuyon, Tigaon, Camarines Sur, to **PROCEED** with the revision of paper ballots; and **DIRECT** the Revision Supervisors to **CONTINUE** with the revision of ballot boxes under similar circumstances;

(x) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated May 30, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 7 (Precincts 21A, 22A, 23A, 24A and 25A), Brgy. San Francisco (Pob.), Iriga City, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 23, which reads 'there is no explanation in the MOVs with regard to the usage of two MOV forms. The entries in the two MOVs have substantial discrepancies. It cannot be determined with certainty which of the two was actually used or both were used. As for the different signatures of the BEI chairman in the official ballots, MOVs and envelopes, it cannot be ascertained if signatures were made by the BEI chairman or signed by different persons'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for revised Clustered Precinct No. 7, Brgy. San Francisco (Pob.), Iriga City, Camarines Sur, to (1) **CONTINUE** with the revision of paper ballots and (2) **REFLECT** the entries of both Minutes of Voting in the Revision Report; and **DIRECT** the Chairperson of the Board of Election Inspectors to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, why there are two (2) Minutes of Voting inside the ballot box;

(xi) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated May 30, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 45 (Precincts 0092A, 0093B, 0093C and 0093D), Brgy. Vinagre, Tigaon, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 26, which reads 'the signatures of BEI Chair on the ballots cannot be compared to any similar specimen in the other documents. As to the zip ties, three (3) of them with serial nos. 0249568 and two (2) without the part where serial nos. are written were not attached to the ballot box and were already cut. Another zip tie (serial# 0249570) was attached but already cut; zip ties with serial nos. 0249569 and 0249571 were properly attached and locked'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for revised Clustered Precinct No. 45 Brgy. Vinagre, Tigaon, Camarines Sur, to **CONTINUE** with the revision of paper ballots; and **DIRECT** the Municipal Treasurer of Tigaon, Camarines Sur, to **EXPLAIN** the observations in the subject Incident Report within ten (10) days from notice hereof;

(xii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated May 30, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 22 (Precincts 60A, 60B, 61A and 62A), Brgy. La Purisima, Iriga City, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 17, which reads 'The integrity of the ballots are doubtful due to the following reasons: (i) The two MOVs pertain to the


same clustered precinct no. but were signed by two different BEI Chairmen (ii) A number of ballots having only one signature is not the same signature of BEI Chair as shown on any of the two MOVS'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for revised Clustered Precinct No. 22, Brgy. La Purisima, Iriga City, Camarines Sur, to (1) **CONTINUE** with the revision of paper ballots and (2) **REFLECT** the entries of both Minutes of Voting in the Revision Report; and **DIRECT** the Chairperson of the Board of Election Inspectors to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, why there are two (2) Minutes of Voting inside the ballot box;

(xiii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated May 31, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 41 (Precincts 0115A, 0115B, 0116A and 0116B), Brgy. San Antonio, Iriga City, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 8, which reads 'No specimen for signature may be used to compare the signatures on the ballots because of the missing contents of the ballot box (i.e. MOV, ER, other envelopes)'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for revised Clustered Precinct No. 41, Brgy. San Antonio, Iriga City, Camarines Sur, to **PROCEED** with the revision of paper ballots; and **DIRECT** the Revision Supervisors to **CONTINUE** with the revision of ballot boxes under similar circumstances;

(xiv) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated May 31, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 43 (Precincts 0121A, 0122A, 0123A and 0123B), Brgy. San Isidro, Iriga, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 3, which reads 'The signature of the Chairman of BEI on the MOV and other documents are totally different from his/her signature on the official ballots'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for revised Clustered Precinct No. 43, Brgy. San Isidro, Iriga, Camarines Sur, to **PROCEED** with the revision of paper ballots; and **DIRECT** the Revision Supervisors to **CONTINUE** with the revision of ballot boxes under similar circumstances; and

(xv) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated June 4, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 87 (Precincts 242A, 242B, 242C and 243A), Brgy. Sto. Domingo, Iriga, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 34, which reads 'Ballots got wet'; and **APPROVE** the recommendation to 'suspend revision.'" (2)
