THIRD MANIFESTATION OF GRAVE CONCERN

PROTESTEE MARIA LEONOR G. ROBREDO, by the undersigned counsel, to the Honorable Tribunal, respectfully states:

1. During the briefing prior to the start of the revision, recount and re-appreciation of the ballots, the Honorable Tribunal informed the parties the proper decorum to be observed and only papers can be brought inside.

2. In fact, during the first day of the revision, recount and re-appreciation of ballots, the parties, through counsels and their respective revision supervisors, were reminded of the rules to be observed.

3. Surprisingly, on 14 June 2018, at around 9:50 o'clock in the morning, Mr. Nestor Borrromeo, revisor for protestant Ferdinand R. Marcoss, Jr. (hereafter "Marcos" for brevity) was able to bring inside a magnifying plastic lens.

4. The plastic magnifying lens is among the items not allowed to be brought inside the revision area.

5. To further compound matters, Mr. Borrromeo was caught not only in possession of said magnifying glass but was using the same during the ongoing revision, recount and re-appreciation of ballots.

6. Worse, when confronted, Mr. Borrromeo said that he was instructed to stray more valid ballots for protestee Maria Leonor G. Robredo (hereafter "Robredo" for brevity) even after the Head Revisor of the Honorable Tribunal has segregated the ballots.

7. While protestee Robredo understands the need for each revisor to assiduously represent the parties, the rules laid down by the Honorable Tribunal must still be observed.

8. In short, the parties, counsels and representatives must still observe proper decorum and comply with the rules of the Honorable Tribunal during the revision, recount and re-appreciation of ballots.
