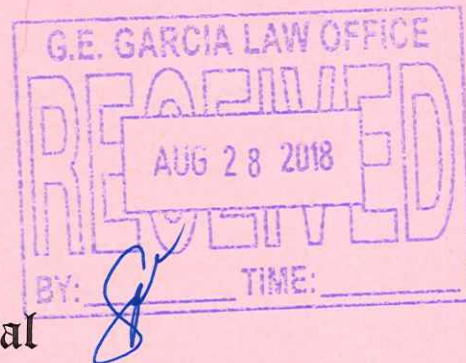

NOTICE

Sirs/Mesdames:

*Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated **JULY 31, 2018**, which reads as follows:*

“P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor ‘Leni Daang Matuwid’ G. Robredo).- The Tribunal Resolved to

(a) **NOTE** the Letter dated July 13, 2018 of Delsie R. Villareal, Head Revisor assigned at Revision Committee No. 15 on June 14, 2018, submitting her explanation relative to the Incident Report dated June 14, 2018 re: Table No. 15 which reads ‘The Head Revisor observed/saw a rectangular lens on top of the ballots being revised by the party revisor for the protestant xxx’;

(b) **NOTE** the Letter dated July 13, 2018 of Sally H. Nisola, Alternate Head Revisor at Table No. 21, submitting her explanation on the Incident Report (Re: Misplaced Election Receipt) dated May 25, 2018 in compliance with the resolution dated June 19, 2018;

(c) **NOTE** the Letter dated July 16, 2018 of Princess Bometivo, Head Revisor at Table No. 7, submitting her explanation relative to the Incident Report dated June 14, 2018 (Re: One Piece of Voter’s Verification Receipt [VVR] Left Under Table No. 7, Care of Head Revisor Princess Bometivo) in compliance with the resolution dated July 10, 2018;

(d) **NOTE** the Letter dated July 17, 2018 of Wenifreda G. Efondo, Acting Municipal Treasurer, Municipality of Sipocot, Camarines Sur, submitting her explanation relative to (i) Incident Report dated May 2, 2018 (Re: Clustered Precinct No. 46) and (ii) Incident Reports, all dated April 30, 2018, (Re: Clustered Precinct Nos. 13, 7 and 17) in compliance with the resolution dated June 5, 2018;

(e) **NOTE** and **REFER** to the PET Commissioners, for appropriate action, the Explanation dated July 24, 2018 filed by Jennifer G. Vargas, Chairperson, Board of Election Inspectors of Clustered Precinct No. 32 of Barangay Palsong,

Bula, Camarines Sur during the May 9, 2016 National and Local Elections, in compliance with the resolution dated June 5, 2018; and

(f) **NOTE** the Letter dated July 25, 2018 of Atty. Michael L. Garcia, Division Clerk, First Division, Commission on Elections (COMELEC), in connection with EAC No. 09-2018 (Ferdaus W. Radja, protestant-appellant vs. Carlusa A. Climaco, protestee-appellee) pending before the COMELEC First Division involving the position of Mayor in the Municipality of Tungawan, Province of Zamboanga Sibugay, stating that there is no record that would show that prior authority from the Tribunal was obtained with respect to the possession and custody of the ballot boxes, election documents and related paraphernalia when the court of origin ordered the revision of the subject ballots and **ALLOW** the COMELEC to **CONTINUE** with the proceedings in EAC No. 09-2018.

The Tribunal further Resolved, upon the recommendation of the PET Commissioners, to

(a) **DIRECT** the Revision Committees which started the revision of the ballot boxes from Clustered Precinct Nos. 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, 15, 18 and 40, all in the Municipality of Tinambac, Camarines Sur, to (i) **CONTINUE** with the revision and (ii) **REFLECT** the observations made in the pertinent Incident Reports in their respective Revision Reports;

(b) **DIRECT** all the Revision Committees, through their respective Head Revisors and Revision Supervisors, in similar instances where there are irregularities in the external condition of the ballot boxes under revision, to nevertheless (i) **PROCEED** with the revision of ballots if there are no positive signs of damage to, or tampering or substitution of, the ballots themselves, and (ii) **REFLECT** such irregularities in the Revision Reports;

(c) **REQUIRE** the Board of Election Inspectors of Clustered Precinct No. 41, Brgy. Oroc-Osoc, Caramoan, Camarines Sur, to **EXPLAIN** why the used ballots in said Clustered Precinct No. 41 were torn in half lengthwise and bundled with packaging tape; and

(d) **DIRECT** the Revision Committee for Clustered Precinct No. 41, Brgy. Oroc-Osoc, Caramoan, Camarines Sur, to **PROCEED** with the revision proceedings using the

decrypted picture images of the ballots.” (1)
