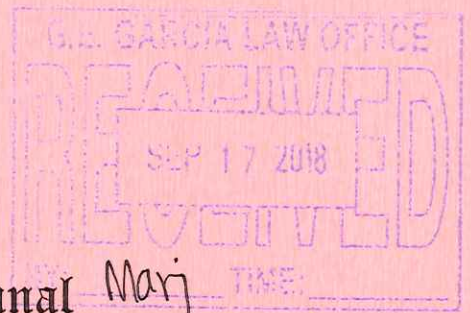

NOTICE

Sirs/Mesdames:

Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated SEPTEMBER 11, 2018, which reads as follows:

"P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand 'Bongbong' R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor 'Leni Daang Matuwid' G. Robredo).- Acting on the following Incident Reports relative to the on-going revision of ballots, the Tribunal Resolved to

(i) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated August 17, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 113 (Precincts 02020A and 0203A), Brgy. Tan-Agan, Municipality of Miagao, Iloilo, at Table No. 14, which reads 'Wet and damaged ballots and other contents in ballot box'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** decrypted ballots; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of Miagao, Iloilo, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above conditions of the ballots;

(ii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated August 17, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 96 (Precincts 168A, 169A, 170A, 171A and 172A), Brgy. Oyungan, Municipality of Miagao, Iloilo, at Table No. 16, which reads 'Wet ballots'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** decrypted ballots; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of Miagao, Iloilo, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above conditions of the ballots;

(iii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated August 23, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 27 (Precincts 69A, 70A and 71A), Brgy. Botong, Municipality of Oton, Iloilo, at Table No. 22, which reads 'The question is whether the paper ballots are genuine or spurious considering the following observations: in two (2) paper ballots during authentication and segregation, when placed under the UV lamp, the ballot security mark on the front page appears blurred while the ballots security mark on the back page does not appear. One paper ballot shade of green ink appears different from the rest of the paper ballots. The shade of yellow ink in the two ballots used to indicate the year '2016' appears lighter than in the rest of the ballots'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** decrypted ballots; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of Oton,

Iloilo, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above conditions of the ballots;

(iv) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated August 23, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 29 (Precincts 0074A, 0075A, 0076A and 0077A), Brgy. Buray, Municipality of Oton, Iloilo, at Table No. 13, which reads 'Ballot box was assigned on August 22, 2018 to Table No. 13; allegedly sealed with packaging tape only, not with standard security seals. Members of the RC had conflicting observations on whether the packaging tape was signed by BEI or not. Revision Supervisor cannot make any observation about the packaging tape or how the ballot box was sealed as the tape was already disposed of; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** decrypted ballots; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of Oton, Iloilo, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballot box;

(v) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated August 24, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 44 (Precincts 118A, 119A, 120A, 120B and 120PI), Brgy. Galang, Municipality of Oton, Iloilo, at Table No. 34, which reads 'The Head Revisor of Table No. 34 reported that upon scrutiny, he found that the total number of ballots cast indicated in the machine-printed Status Report did not tally with the total number of the paper ballots, as counted and as indicated in the MOV. The Status Report indicated only 309 ballots cast versus 603 paper ballots counted or almost 50% difference. There is also a discrepancy in the total number of registered voters; 704 in the MOV vs. 703 in the Status Report; and number of unused ballots: 98 in the MOV vs. 95 per physical count. The number of the voter's receipt did not match the number of paper ballots as counted and as indicated in the MOV, and also as printed in the Status Report, 599 VR only. The number of ballots used per MOV is 605 as against 603 per physical count. The MOV also stated one (1) rejected ballot but no envelope for rejected ballot or the rejected ballot itself was found inside the ballot box'; and **DIRECT** the Head Revisor and Revision Supervisor assigned to (i) **AUTHENTICATE** the subject paper ballots and, thereafter, (ii) **CONTINUE** with the revision, if all the ballots are found to be authentic or, if not, **FOLLOW** Rule 74 of the Presidential Electoral Tribunal (PET) Revisor's Guide for the Revision of Ballots under the Automated Election System and **REFER** the matter to this Tribunal for appropriate action;

(vi) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated August 28, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 12 (Precincts 33A, 34A and 35A), Brgy. Agdayao, Municipality of Pabi, Iloilo, at Table No. 13, which reads 'No Minutes of Voting; No Election Returns; only contents of the ballot box: ballots and Transmission Report'; and **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to (i) **CONTINUE**

with the revision and (ii) **NOTE** the aforequoted observations in their Revision Report;

(vii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated August 28, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 28 (Precincts 0079A, 0080A and 0080B), Brgy. Bayan, Municipality of Passi, Iloilo, at Table No. 28, which reads 'No Minutes of Voting; No Election returns'; and **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to (i) **CONTINUE** with the revision and (ii) **NOTE** the aforequoted observations in their Revision Report;

(viii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated August 28, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 25 (Precincts 68A, 69A, 70A, 71A and 71B), Brgy. Bacuranan, City of Passi, Iloilo, at Table No. 38, which reads 'No Minutes of Voting; No Election Returns; no Voters receipt, ER envelope is sealed but empty'; and **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to (i) **CONTINUE** with the revision and (ii) **NOTE** the aforequoted observations in their Revision Report;

(ix) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated August 28, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 38 (Precincts 106A, 106B and 107A), Brgy. Gegachac, City of Passi, Iloilo, at Table No. 35, which reads 'the integrity of the ballots was not preserved; the contents of some ballots are already illegible'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** decrypted ballots; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of Passi, Iloilo, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above conditions of the ballots;

(x) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated August 28, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 26 (Precincts 72A, 73A, 74A and 74B), Brgy. Bagacay, City of Passi, Iloilo, at Table No. 18, which reads 'No Minutes of Voting; No Election Returns; only contents of box were ballots, torn ballots and voter's receipt'; and **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to (i) **CONTINUE** with the revision and (ii) **NOTE** the aforequoted observations in their Revision Report; and

(xi) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated August 28, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 29 (Precincts 0081A, 0082A, 0083A and 0083B), Brgy. Bitagan, City of Passi, Iloilo, at Table No. 13, which reads 'No Minutes of Voting; Election Returns & torn ballots; Contents of box: ballots & voter's receipts only'; and **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to (i) **CONTINUE** with the revision and (ii) **NOTE** the aforequoted observations in their Revision Report.

The Tribunal further Resolved to

(a) **NOTE** the Memorandum dated September 4, 2018 of Atty. Linuel G. Alindogan, PET Retrieval Team Leader, and Court Attorney IV, Office of Chief Attorney,

informing the Tribunal that the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) delivered a total of thirty-seven (37) ballot boxes and records on June 19, 2018 while the House of Representatives Electoral Tribunal (HRET) delivered three hundred sixty-five (365) ballot boxes, forty-five (45) black boxes plus three (3) black boxes containing ballots with votes of voters, as per Joint Affidavit issued by the respective Board of Election Inspectors of Clustered Precinct Nos. 105, 103 and 73, all from the City of Naga; that, in addition, sixty-nine (69) pieces of Election Day Computerized Voter's List (EDCVL)/PCVL and books, some of which were inside one hundred ninety-four (194) sacks, and thirty-one (31) bundles of books were also delivered; that it was observed during the actual inventory that some ballot boxes appear to be wet, cracked or broken while others have damaged bases or covers; that some plastic seals were either lacking/missing, double, broken, detached, unlocked or not in their proper places; and that some metal seals were missing or detached while ninety-one (91) ballot boxes, which were already revised by the HRET, already have HRET seals attached on both sides; **DIRECT** PET *Ad Hoc* Committee to obtain protestant's conformity to the cost of the retrieval;

(b) **NOTE** the Manifestation dated September 6, 2018 filed by counsel for COMELEC, stating that, on August 8, 2018, the COMELEC *En Banc*, in its Regular Meeting, promulgated Minute Resolution No. 18-0633 which approved with modification the request of Director J. Thaddeus P. Hernan of the Administrative Services Department, concurred in by Executive Director Jose M. Tolentino, Jr., for authority to temporarily issue laptop computers to certain offices of the COMELEC to be taken from the unused 2016 CCS Contingency Laptops stored at the COMELEC warehouse in Sta. Rosa City, Laguna which are not covered by the Precautionary Protection Order issued by this Tribunal or the Protection Order issued by the Senate Electoral Tribunal; and informing the Tribunal that the intended pull-out of the said Contingency Laptops from the COMELEC Warehouse at Sta. Rosa City, Laguna will be on September 14, 2018, 10:00 o'clock a.m.;

(c) **NOTE** the Letter dated September 6, 2018 of Executive Director Tolentino, Jr. relative to the Order dated August 14, 2018 of the HRET in HRET Case No. 16-005 (EP) (Luis R. Villafuerte, Protestant vs. Gabriel H. Bordado, Jr., Protestee), seeking authority to produce the audit logs of the Calabanga, Camarines Sur, CCS laptops; and

(d) **AUTHORIZE** the COMELEC to **PRODUCE** the aforesaid audit logs of the Calabanga CCS laptops and **INFORM** the Tribunal and the parties of the status and result of the said activity.

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Acting on the Memorandum dated September 7, 2018 of Atty. Alindogan, the Tribunal likewise Resolved to

(a) **AUTHORIZE** the travel to Negros Oriental Province, on the date deemed best by the PET *Ad Hoc* Committee, of the PET Retrieval Team composed of the following personnel:

[NOTE: The Retrieval Team shall be lodged at the Hotel Nicanor, Dumaguete City. If the said hotel is not available on the period of retrieval, the Fiesole Residence Inn will serve as an alternate.];

(b) **DIRECT** all City and Municipal Treasurers and Election Officers to **DELIVER** to the PET Retrieval Team at the designated staging area/hub at the 2GO Warehouse, Looc Street, Flores Avenue, Dumaguete City, all the ballot boxes and their contents with their keys if with lock, list of voters, particularly the EDCVL and voters registration records (VRRs), book of voters and other election documents and paraphernalia used in the 2016 National and Local Elections, as scheduled below:

(c) **DIRECT** Judge Mario O. Trinidad, Presiding Judge, Branch 64, Regional Trial Court, Guinhulngan City, where an election case in the Municipality of Vallehermoso is pending, to **DELIVER** to the PET Retrieval Team at 2Go Warehouse, Looc Street, Flores Avenue, Dumaguete City, under proper receipt and with notice to the parties, the list of voters, particularly the EDCVL and VRRs, book of voters from the Municipality of Vallehermoso and ballot boxes, if any;

(d) **DIRECT** the COMELEC to **DELIVER** to the Tribunal, through the PET Office, the ten (10) ballot boxes in its possession subject of the random manual audit from the Province of Negros Oriental;

(e) **DIRECT** the Negros Oriental Police Provincial Officer of the Philippine National Police and the respective Chiefs of Police of the cities and municipalities of Negros Oriental to **PROVIDE** adequate police security and escorts when the ballot boxes and other election documents and paraphernalia are transported for delivery from the respective municipalities and cities mentioned above to the Retrieval Team's staging area/hub at the 2Go Warehouse, Looc Street, Flores Avenue, Dumaguete City;

(f) **DIRECT** the Manila Police District Director of the City of Manila to **PROVIDE** adequate police escort security to the Philippine Postal Corporation (PHLPost) container vans when the convoy of trucks carrying the ballot boxes and other election documents and paraphernalia enter their police area of jurisdiction from the Manila Port Area to the SC-CA Building, Ma. Orosa Street, Ermita, Manila;

(g) **AUTHORIZE** the PET Retrieval Team to **REIMBURSE** the cost of transportation/trucking expenses incurred by the Municipal/City Treasurers/Election Officers in connection with the delivery/collection of the ballot boxes and other election documents and paraphernalia, provided that such expenses are properly receipted by official receipts or, in the absence thereof, by a certification by the Municipal/City

Treasurer concerned;

(h) **AUTHORIZE** the PHLPost, as the official carrier for transporting the ballot boxes and other election documents and paraphernalia from the Negros Oriental Province, to **DELIVER** on a 'door-to-door' basis the said ballot boxes and election documents and paraphernalia to the SC-CA Building in Manila;

(i) **AUTHORIZE** Atty. Edgar O. Aricheta, Clerk of the Tribunal, to (1) **SIGN** the *conforme* letter/proposal of PHLPost in connection with the subject delivery and (2) **ENTER** into a contract of lease with PHLPost in connection with the storage/warehousing of all the ballot boxes and other election documents and paraphernalia from the three pilot provinces;

(j) **AUTHORIZE** the PET Retrieval Team to (1) **AUGMENT** the PET ballot box handlers; (2) **HIRE** fifteen (15) local haulers in the locality during the retrieval period; and (3) **PAY** the daily wage prevailing in the locality or the minimum wage rate provided by the National Wages and Productivity Commission; and


