NOTICE

Sirs/Mesdames:

*Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated **SEPTEMBER 18, 2018**, which reads as follows:*

“P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor ‘Leni Daang Matuwid’ G. Robredo).- Acting on the following Incident Reports relative to the on-going revision of ballots, the Tribunal Resolved to

(i) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated September 3, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 8 (Precincts 0027A, 0028A, 0029A, 0030A and 0030B), Brgy. San Jose Ward, Municipality of Pototan, Iloilo, at Table No. 6, which reads ‘Four red plastic security seals were already cut upon arrival of the ballot box at the revision table. Also, the top portion of the ballot box, specifically two portions measuring approximately eight inches by one and a half inches supposedly covered by a small top cover, was only covered with packaging tape. However, the metal lock is still in place. One red plastic security seal is also intact and in place’; and **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to (1) **CONTINUE** with the revision and (2) **NOTE** the aforementioned observations in their Revision Report;

(ii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated September 3, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 14 (Precincts 42A, 42B, 43A and 44A), Brgy. Barasan, Municipality of Pototan, Iloilo, at Table No. 16, which reads ‘The ballots inside the boxes are inconsistent with the details of the precinct in the box as well as the ER, MOV and torn ballots. There is a possibility that the ballots were swapped with the ballots in Table 37, which had the same problem’ and Incident Report dated September 3, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct Nos. 14 (15) (Precincts 0042A, 0042B, 0043A and 0044A), Brgy. Barasan, Municipality of Pototan, Iloilo, at Table No. 37, which reads ‘The contents of the ballot box are inconsistent with respect to the particular identifiers (i.e., precinct number cluster details). The particulars of the Ballot Box is (sic) consistent with the details in the MOV (i.e., ID No. 30370015) as well as with the torn ballot details but the ballots which were counted had the ID detail of 30370014. Some of the locks of the box were also

noted to be unfastened. Initial observation seems to be that the contents of the box may have been switched with the box assigned to Table No. 16 (as they also encountered box contents which were different from the ballot box particulars'; **DIRECT** the respective Revision Committees to (1) **SIMULTANEOUSLY OPEN** the ballot boxes, (2) **TRANSFER** the ballots to their proper boxes such that all election paraphernalia (Minutes of Voting, Election Return, and the ballots) shall belong to the same Clustered Precinct, and, thereafter, (3) **CONTINUE** with the revision; and **DIRECT** the Municipal Treasurer of Pototan, Iloilo, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the aforementioned observations in the subject Incident Reports;

(iii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated September 11, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 27 (Precincts 59A and 60A), Brgy. Cubay, Municipality of San Joaquin, Iloilo, at Table No. 20, which reads 'When the head revisor with the party representatives opened the ballot box, they discovered that all ballots were torn in half. These ballots had shaded votes and the signature of the Chairman'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of San Joaquin, Iloilo, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballots;

(iv) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated September 10, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 39 (Precincts 0090A, 0090B, 0091A and 0092A), Brgy. Tambunac, Municipality of San Enrique, Iloilo, at Table No. 37, which reads 'The ballots are found to be either wet or already dried but with brown dirt covering portions thereof. The ballots at the bottom of the box are moldy and damaged. They can no longer be authenticated by the UV detector'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of San Enrique, Iloilo, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballots;

(v) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated September 12, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 69 (Precincts 0124A and 0125A), Brgy. Nagsipit, Municipality of San Joaquin, Iloilo, at Table No. 8, which reads 'Ballots inside ballot box are wet'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of San Joaquin, Iloilo, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballots;

(vi) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated September 12, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 74 (Precincts 0132A and 0133A), Brgy. Qui-Anan, Municipality of San Joaquin, Iloilo, at Table No. 32, which reads 'Ballots can no longer be revised';

DIRECT the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of San Joaquin, Iloilo, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballots that they can no longer be revised;

(vii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated September 12, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 86 (Precincts 056A and 0157A), Brgy. Talagutac, Municipality of San Joaquin, Iloilo, at Table No. 16, which reads 'The ballots were found damaged and covered with mold and mildew. Many of the ballots were stuck together. Revision is no longer possible'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of San Joaquin, Iloilo, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballots;

(viii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated September 12, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 54 (Precincts 0098A, 0099A, 0100A and 0101A), Brgy. Lawigan, Municipality of San Joaquin, Iloilo, at Table No. 39, which reads 'Wet ballots that have already dried and stuck together; damaged security watermarks on ballots'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of San Joaquin, Iloilo, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballots; and

(ix) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated September 12, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 88 (Precincts 0159A, 0159B, 0160A and 0160B), Brgy. Taslan, Municipality of San Joaquin, Iloilo, at Table No. 31, which reads 'Upon opening of the ballot box, the ballots were found to be wet, stuck together and covered with molds. All of the ballots were damaged and could no longer be revised'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of San Joaquin, Iloilo, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballots.



Robredo, the Court Resolved to **DIRECT** protestant Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr. and Atty. Glenn Chong to **COMMENT** thereon within a **NON-EXTENDIBLE** period of ten (10) days from notice hereof.

The Court further Resolved, upon the recommendation of the PET Hearing Commissioners, to simply **NOTE** the Explanation of Jennifer Vargas, Chairperson, Board of Election Inspectors, Clustered Precinct No. 32, Brgy. Palsong, Bula, Camarines Sur, considering that the replacement of the subject ballot was justified under Section 42 of the Amended

COMELEC Resolution No. 10057 which allows the replacement of ballots for reasons not attributable to the voter. In this case, the defacement of the ballot was due to the 'accidental stain caused by the stray indelible ink as identified by the BEI Chairman.'" Carpio, J., on official leave.
