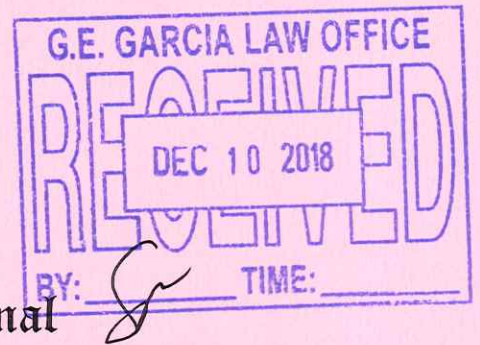

Sirs/Mesdames:

*Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated **DECEMBER 4, 2018**, which reads as follows:*

“P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor ‘Leni Daang Matuwid’ G. Robredo).-

In the Resolution dated June 19, 2018, the Tribunal granted protestee’s request to photocopy stray ballots, particularly the ballots containing votes or voting marks in her favor. Protestant was also directed to manifest whether he intends to make a similar request.

During the meeting with the parties’ counsel on October 30, 2018, counsel for protestee, Atty. Emil Marañon III, manifested that they will also request for the photocopying of the VCM-rejected ballots. To this date, the Tribunal has not yet received any manifestation from the protestant and the protestee on said matters.

To expedite proceedings, the Tribunal allows both parties to photocopy **stray and/or VCM-rejected ballots**. The photocopying shall start on December 12, 2018, 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., at the designated area in the Revision Hall. Parties may send representatives to observe the proceedings. No further requests to reopen the ballot boxes shall be allowed after each box has been reopened, the stray and/or VCM-rejected ballots therein photocopied, and thereafter closed.

The Tribunal further Resolves to

(a) **NOTE** the Comment (on Protestant Marcos’ Manifestation of Appreciation for Sustaining Rule 43[L] of the 2010 Rules of the Presidential Electoral Tribunal with Omnibus Motion) dated November 27, 2018 filed by counsel for the Commission on Elections in compliance with the resolution dated October 16, 2018; and

(b) **REQUIRE** protestant Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr. to file a **REPLY** to the above Comment within ten (10) days from notice hereof.
