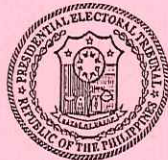

“P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor ‘Leni Daang Matuwid’ G. Robredo).- The Tribunal Resolved to

(a) **NOTE** the Consolidated Reply (to the [i] Comment of the Commission on Elections and [ii] Comment/Opposition of protestee Maria Leonor G. Robredo [both relative to protestant’s Manifestation of Appreciation for Sustaining Rule 43(L) of the 2010 Rules of the Presidential Electoral Tribunal with Omnibus Motion]) dated December 20, 2018 filed by counsel for protestant Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr. in compliance with the resolution dated December 4, 2018;

(b) **NOTE** the Supplemental Manifestation (to the Counter-Manifestation with Comment and Opposition dated January 14, 2019), dated January 21, 2019 filed by counsel for protestee Robredo;

(c) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated January 16, 2019 re: Clustered Precinct No. 25 (Precincts 0066A, 0067A and 0067B), Brgy. Cali, Dumangas, Iloilo, at Table No. 21, which reads ‘Wet ballots; On July 19, 2018 the assigned revision supervisor suspended the revision of the subject ballot box and recommended that the ballots’ picture images be revised instead. However, she failed to recommend for the decryption of the ballot box’s SD card pursuant to Rule 74 of the PET Revisor’s Guide’; and **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **PROCEED** with the revision using the decrypted ballot images; and

(d) **NOTE** the Letter-Explanation dated January 14, 2019 of Imelda C. Mariscal, Municipal Treasurer, Canaman, Camarines Sur, relative to Incident Reports dated April 23, 2018 and April 24, 2018.



Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated NOVEMBER 27, 2018, which reads as follows:

“P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor ‘Leni Daang Matuwid’ G. Robredo).- The Court Resolved to

(a) **NOTE** the Strong Reply with Motion to the Counter-Manifestation with Motion to Release CCTV Footage of the Revisor of Protestant Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr., dated July 19, 2018 filed by counsel for protestant Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr., praying, among others, for the Tribunal to investigate and direct protestee Leonor ‘Leni Daang Matuwid’ G. Robredo and her legal counsels to explain how they obtained the information regarding the actions taken by this Tribunal in connection with the ‘Pansol outing’ of the PET personnel and protestee’s revisor;

(b) **NOTE** the Comment and Opposition (on/to the Omnibus Motion [i] for Partial Reconsideration and/or Clarification of PET Resolution dated September 18, 2018 with Regard to the Amendment of Rule 62 of the PET Revisor’s Guide and the Directive to the Head Revisors to Refer to the Election Returns [ERs] to Mimic or Verify the Total Number of Votes as Read and Counted by the Vote Counting Machines [VCMs]; and [ii] for Partial Reconsideration of the Denial of Protestant’s Strong Opposition [on (sic) the Use of Decrypted Ballot Images for the Judicial Revision and Recount of Ballots for the Pilot Protested Precincts Subject of this Election Protest]), dated November 16, 2018 filed by counsel for protestee Robredo;

(c) **REQUIRE** protestant Marcos, Jr. to file a **REPLY** to the above Comment and Opposition within ten (10) days from notice hereof;

(d) **NOTE** the Explanation filed by Vivian S. Napano, Acting Municipal Treasurer, San Joaquin, Iloilo, in compliance with the resolution dated September 18, 2018 relative to (i) Incident Report dated September 11, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 27 (Precincts 59A and 60A), Brgy. Cubay, Municipality of San Joaquin, Iloilo; (ii) Incident Report dated

September 12, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 69 (Precincts 0124A and 0125A), Brgy. Nagsipit, Municipality of San Joaquin, Iloilo; and [iii] Incident Report dated September 12, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 88 (Precincts 0159A, 0159B, 0160A and 0160B), Brgy. Taslan, Municipality of San Joaquin, Iloilo;

(e) **NOTE** the Memorandum dated November 15, 2017 (should be 2018) filed by Evelyn P. Flores, Election Officer III, Nabua, Camarines Sur, in compliance with the resolution dated October 16, 2018, submitting the Letter-Explanation of Anastacio O. Bongalos, Municipal Treasurer, Nabua, Camarines Sur, relative to Clustered Precinct No. 30 (Precincts 0071D, 0072A, 0073A and 0074A), Brgy. La Purisima Agupit, Nabua, Camarines Sur;

(f) **NOTE** the aforesaid Letter-Explanation dated November 15, 2018 filed by Anastacio O. Bongalos in compliance with the resolution dated October 16, 2018;

(g) **NOTE** the Letter dated November 8, 2018 filed by Althea June P. Robles, Acting Municipal Treasurer, Leganes, Iloilo, in compliance with the resolution dated August 28, 2018, relative to Incident Reports dated August 8, 2018 re: (i) Clustered Precinct No. 32 (Precincts 0079B, 0080A, 0080B, 0082A and 0082B), Brgy. Napnud, Leganes, Iloilo; (ii) Clustered Precinct No. 29 (Precincts 0073A, 0073B, 0077A and 0077B), Brgy. Nabitasan, Leganes, Iloilo; (iii) Clustered Precinct No. 21 (Precincts 0047A, 0049A, 0050A, 0052A and 0052B), Brgy. Guihaman, Leganes, Iloilo; and (iv) Clustered Precinct No. 26 (Precincts 0066A, 0067A, 0068A, 0068B and 0069A), Brgy. Lapayon, Leganes, Iloilo;

(h) **CONSIDER** as **SERVED** the resolution dated July 24, 2018 addressed to Cynthia Patag, Puerto Real, La Paz, Iloilo, which resolution was returned unserved with notation on the letter-envelope 'RTS No One to Receive'; and

(i) **GRANT** the Motion dated November 14, 2018 filed by the Commission on Elections for an extension of fifteen (15) days from November 15, 2018, or until November 30, 2018, within which to file a comment on the Manifestation of Appreciation for Sustaining Rule 43[L] of the 2010 Rules of the Presidential Electoral Tribunal with Omnibus Motion.

Acting on the following Incident Reports relative to the on-going revision of ballots, the Tribunal further Resolved to

(i) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated November 8, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 10 (Precincts 0020A, 0020B and 0020C), Brgy. Cabcan, Bindoy (Payabon), Negros Oriental, at Table No. 17, which reads 'HR reported that the

number of physical ballots does not match with the number of votes cast indicated in the ER. The number of physical ballots is 289 while the number of votes cast in the ER is 403, or 114 missing ballots. The BEI explained the discrepancy in a letter found inside the ballot box – the VCM stopped working and the BEI had to borrow the VCM in CP No. 9 and inserted the SD card into the borrowed machine to continue with the voting. However, this discrepancy makes it impossible for the RC to compare the actual votes garnered by each party with the figures in the ER'; and **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images;

(ii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated November 9, 2018 re: 'misabeled ballot boxes; numerous ballot boxes did not reflect the correct clustered precinct numbers'; and **DIRECT** the Head Revisors, always with the confirmation of the Revision Supervisors, to **REFLECT** the Clustered Precinct as indicated in the ballot boxes but likewise **MAKE A NOTE** of the correct Clustered Precinct after checking the contents of the ballot boxes;

(iii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated November 12, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 8 (Precincts 0017A, 0017B, 0018A and 0018B), Brgy. Apo Island, Dauin, Negros Oriental, at Table No. 1, which reads 'No ER. Suspend Revision'; and **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to (1) **RETRIEVE** the decrypted election returns and (2) **CONTINUE** thereafter the revision using the decrypted election returns;

(iv) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated November 15, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 60 (Precincts 0114A, 0115A, 0116A and 0117A), Brgy. Calinpagan, Dumaguete City, Negros Oriental, at Table No. 15, which reads 'No ER for national positions'; and **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to (1) **RETRIEVE** the decrypted election returns and (2) **CONTINUE** thereafter the revision using the decrypted election returns;

(v) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated November 19, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 112 (Precincts 0226B, 0227A, 0228A and 0228B), Brgy. Taclobo, Dumaguete City, Negros Oriental, at Table No. 28, which reads 'No ER; request for ER yielded "no national position results"'; and **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to (1) **RETRIEVE** the decrypted election returns and (2) **CONTINUE** thereafter the revision using the decrypted election returns;

(vi) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated November 19, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 1 (Precincts 0001A, 0001B, 0001C, 0001D and 0001E), Brgy. Poblacion, Guihulngan City, Negros Oriental, at Table No. 23, which reads 'All the ballots used and unused were torn in half (vertically); Upon verifying

the number of ballots, the head revisor found that there were 536 right halves, and only 10 left halves of the ballots'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images; and **REQUIRE** the City Treasurer of Guihulngan City, Negros Oriental, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballots;

(vii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated November 19, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 5 (Precincts 0004B, 0004C, 0005A, 0005B and 0005C), Brgy. Poblacion, Guihulngan City, Negros Oriental, at Table No. 11, which reads 'No ER in the ballot box; Request for copy of ER from PET was denied because "no national position result"'; and **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to (1) **RETRIEVE** the decrypted election returns and (2) **CONTINUE** thereafter the revision using the decrypted election returns; and

(viii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated November 19, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 115 (Precincts 0235A, 0236A, 0237A and 0238A), Brgy. Taclobo, Dumaguete City, Negros Oriental, at Table No. 18, which reads '82 of the used ballots are torn in half; If the torn half ballots are counted, it will total 557, which is one more than the 556 indicated in the ER'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images; and **REQUIRE** the City Treasurer of Dumaguete City, Negros Oriental, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballots. (For release)

The Tribunal likewise Resolved, upon the recommendation of Atty. Maria Carina M. Cunanan, Deputy Clerk of Court and Chief Administrative Officer, to **RENEW** the contractual employment under contracts of services of the following lawyers for the Panel of Commissioners in the Presidential Electoral Tribunal with the same monthly compensation of Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000.00) each:

"P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand 'Bongbong' R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor 'Leni Daang Matuwid' G. Robredo).- Acting on the following Incident Reports relative to the on-going revision of ballots, the Tribunal Resolved to

(i) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated October 8, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 99 (Precincts 0208B, 0209A, 0209B and 0210A), Brgy. Sabang, Naga City, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 50, which reads 'Wet and damaged ballots; Election Returns and MOV are also wet; All the ballots are wet; Although some of them are still readable, they cannot be separated without being damaged; Half of the ballots have already been torn; No longer readable'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of Naga City, Camarines Sur, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballots;

(ii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated October 8, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 104 (Precincts 217C, 218A, 218B and 218C), Brgy. San Felipe, Naga City, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 15, which reads 'Wet/Damaged Ballots; No longer readable'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of Naga City, Camarines Sur, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballots;

(iii) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated October 8, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 109 (Precincts 0223B, 0223C and 0223D), Brgy. San Felipe, Naga City, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 30, which reads 'Ballots are wet and damaged rendering revision impossible; voters' receipts are still intact and can be counted'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of Naga City, Camarines Sur, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballots; and

(iv) **NOTE** the Incident Report dated October 8, 2018 re: Clustered Precinct No. 110 (Precincts 224A, 224B, 225A, 226A and 226B), Brgy. San Francisco (POB), Naga City, Camarines Sur, at Table No. 42, which reads 'Due to wetness and molds, physical count of ballots is not possible'; **DIRECT** the Revision Committee to **REVISE** the decrypted ballot images; and **REQUIRE** the Municipal Treasurer of Naga City, Camarines Sur, to **EXPLAIN**, within ten (10) days from notice hereof, the above condition of the ballots.

The Court further Resolved to
