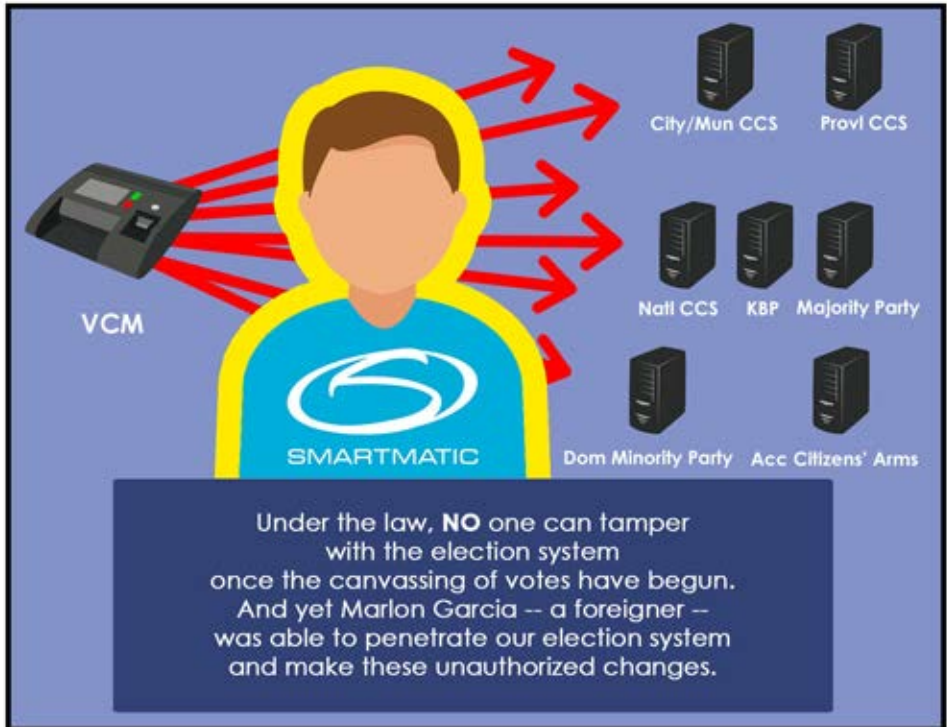


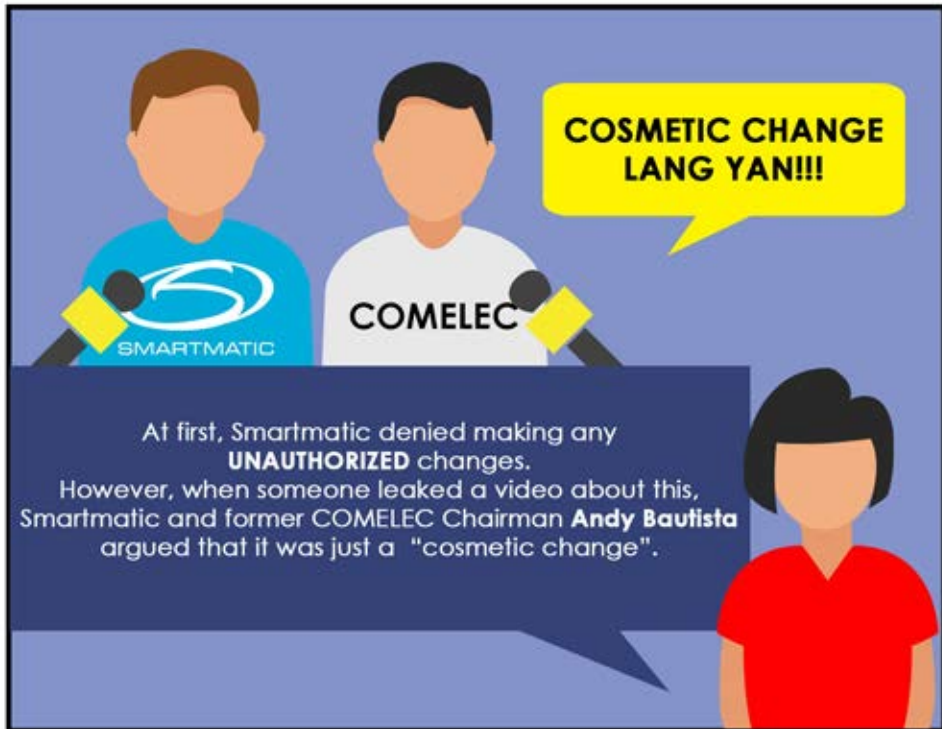
Smartmatic was also caught changing the characters of a (dead) candidates' name on election day.

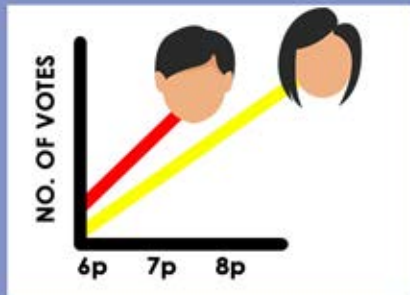
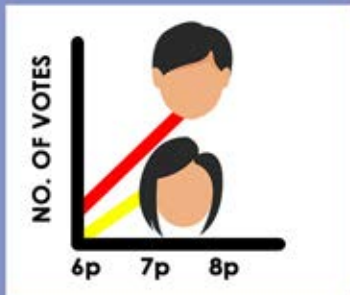

A **ONE MILLION** lead with **79%** of the votes cast is a **CLEAR** victory.  
And yet, SMARTmagic happened . . .







We have seen news reports of widespread terrorism, threats, intimidation and batch feeding of **PRE-SHADED BALLOTS** in ARMM. 

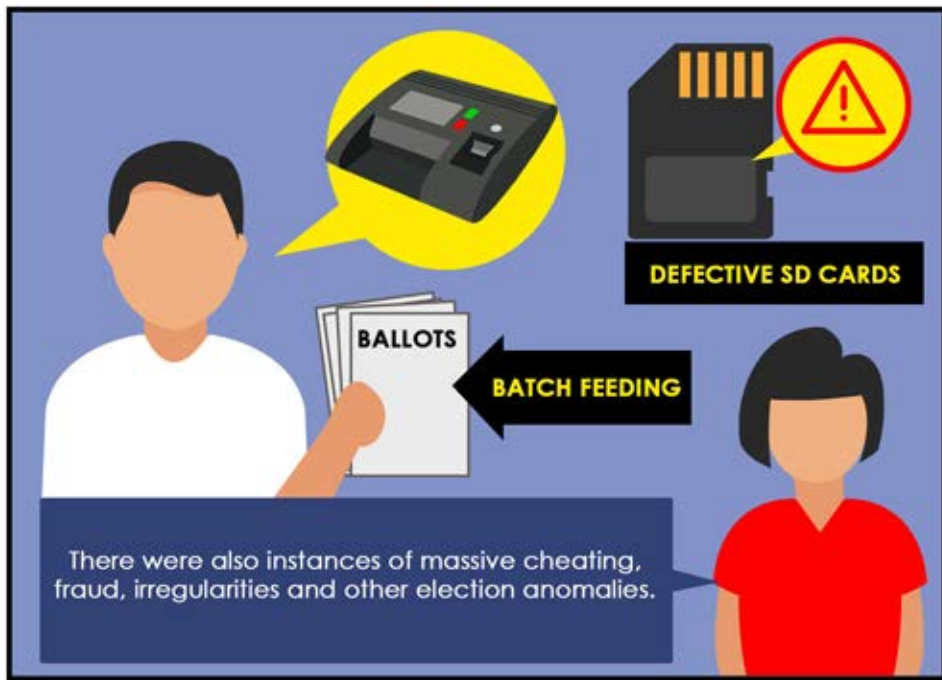

**IN VIEW OF THE FOREGOING**, the Tribunal resolves to:

- a. **DISMISS** protestant's First Cause of Action;

The PET **DISMISSED** BBM's first cause of action. In a Resolution dated 29 August 29, 2017 the PET dismissed BBM's first complaint on account of **"judicial economy and for the prompt disposition of this case"**.

### *Second Cause of Action - Revision and Recount*

Revision and recount of the paper ballots and/or the ballot images as well as an examination, verification, and analysis of the voter's receipts, election returns, audit logs, transmission logs, the lists of voters, particularly the Election Day Computerized Voter's List (EDCVL), and voters registration records (VRRs), the books of voters and other pertinent election documents and/or paraphernalia used in the elections, as well as the automated election equipment and records such as the Vote Counting Machines (VCMs), CCS units, Secure Digital (SD) cards (main and backup), and the other data storage devices containing electronic data and ballot images in ALL of the thirty-six thousand four hundred sixty-five (36,465) protested clustered precincts pursuant to Rules 38 to 45 of the 2010 PET Rules;

Instead of treating this as the **THIRD** Cause of Action (as stated in BBM's **ORIGINAL** Petition), the PET designated this the **SECOND** Cause of Action. Basically, the PET interchanged the 2 when it issued its Resolution dated August 29, 2017.



This is **UNFORTUNATE** because had BBM's "sequence" been followed, the protest would have been **OVER** after a couple of months!!!

Even if the proper "sequence" wasn't followed,  
**BOTH** causes of action can still be heard **AT THE SAME TIME!**

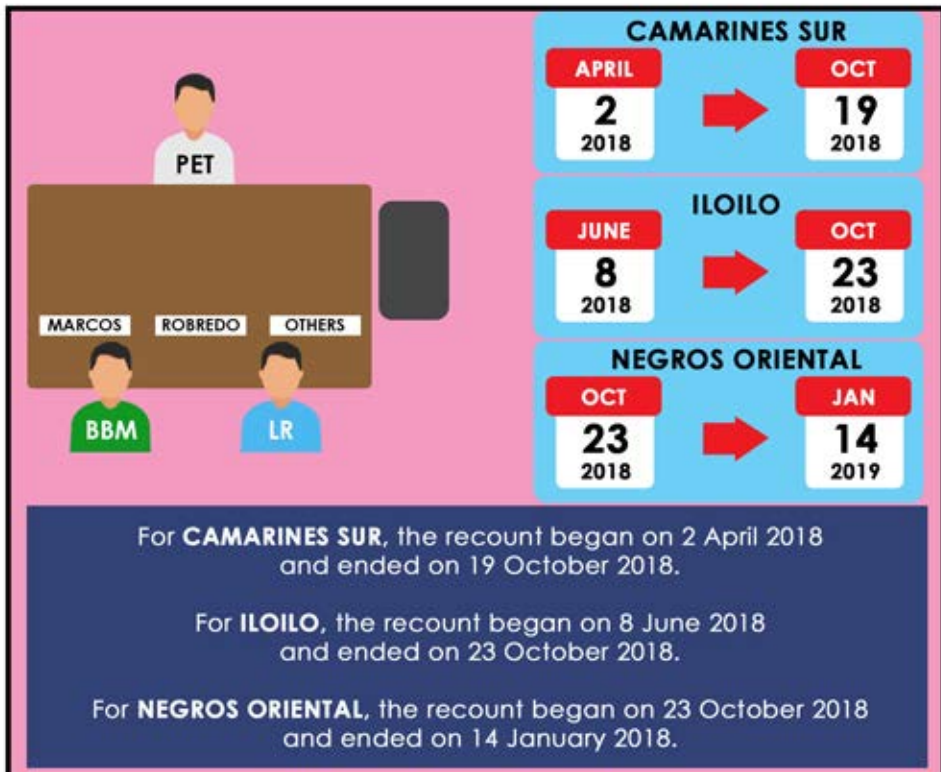

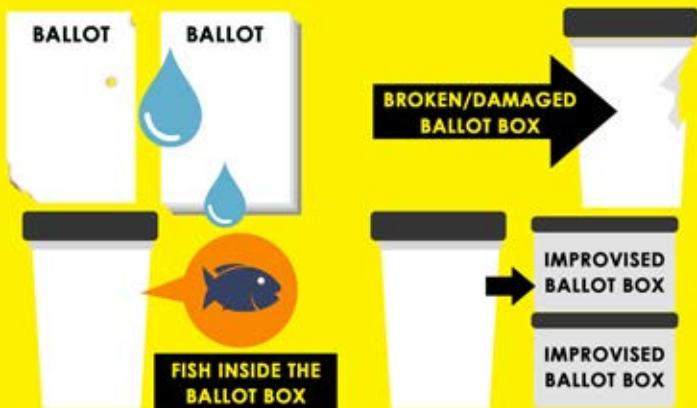

*Third Cause of Action - Annulment of Elections*

Annulment of election results for the position of Vice President in the provinces of Maguindanao, Lanao del Sur and Basilan, on the ground of terrorism, intimidation and harassment of voters as well as pre-shading of ballots in all of the two thousand seven hundred fifty-six (2,756) protested clustered precincts that functioned in the aforesaid areas.

BBM's **THIRD** cause of action is currently the annulment of election results for the position of Vice President in Basilan, Lanao del Sur and Maguindanao. As mentioned earlier, the annulment of votes was **ORIGINALLY** the **SECOND** ground in BBM's Petition but the PET decided to treat it as the **THIRD** cause of action

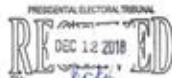



**EXTREMELY URGENT MANIFESTATION OF  
 GRAVE CONCERN WITH OMNIBUS MOTION**

BBM's **THIRD** cause of action is still on-going.

On 12 December 2018,

BBM filed an Extremely Urgent Motion with the PET and asked for a copy of the **RESULTS** of the **TECHNICAL EXAMINATION** conducted by the COMELEC in 508 clustered precincts in Basilan, Lanao del Sur and Maguindanao.

The COMELEC had previously conducted the **TECHNICAL EXAMINATION** as a result of the election protest filed by Sakur Tan against Mujiv Hataman for the position of ARMM Governor.

During the **TECHNICAL EXAMINATION**, the COMELEC discovered that 40,528 **SIGNATURES** and 3,295 **THUMBPRINTS** in the Election Day Computerized Voters List (EDVCLs) **DID NOT MATCH** those that appeared in the Voter's Registration Record (VRR).



This means that almost **80%** of the **SIGNATURES & THUMBMARKS** in these areas were **FAKE**.

Because he will use this as part of his evidence to show  
that there was **RAMPANT** cheating in ARMM.

The Tribunal further Resolved to

(a) **NOTE** the Manifestation and Compliance (Re: List of Witnesses for the Third Cause of Action) dated September 8, 2017 filed by counsel for protestant Marcos, Jr., but **REQUIRE** the protestant to **STRICTLY COMPLY** with the resolution dated August 29, 2017 directing him to identify his witnesses and the concerned clustered precincts subject of their testimonies within a **FINAL** and **NON-EXTENDIBLE** period of **five (5) days** from notice hereof;

This is **APART** from the 7,356 witnesses that BBM submitted to the PET last 9 October 2017 when he was given a "non extendible period of **5 DAYS**" within which to submit the same.

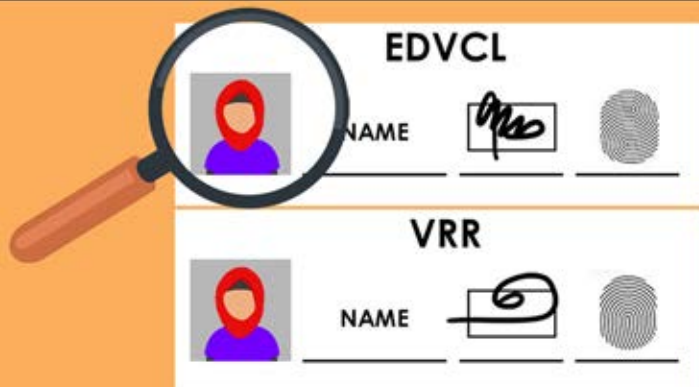

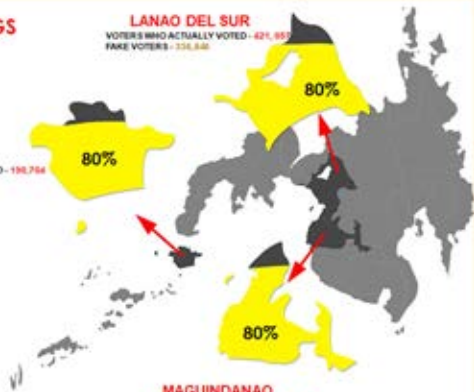
