NOTICE

Please take notice that the Tribunal issued a Resolution dated NOVEMBER 5, 2019, which reads as follows:

“P.E.T. Case No. 005 (Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ R. Marcos, Jr. vs. Maria Leonor ‘Leni Daang Matuwid’ G. Robredo).- The Tribunal Resolved to

(a) **NOTE** and **GRANT** the Letter dated October 22, 2019 of Atty. Maria Bernadette V. Sardillo, counsel for protestee Maria Leonor G. Robredo, informing the Tribunal that they would like to appoint the following as their authorized representatives who can view the Annexes attached to the Resolution dated October 15, 2019, namely:

(c) **DIRECT** the Clerk of the Tribunal to (i) **VERIFY** the addresses of Maria Doris T. Palacio and Mary Sweet Rose A. Tindoc, Board of Election Inspectors, Clustered Precinct No. 118, Tabuco, Naga City and (ii) thereafter **RESEND** to the said addressees the resolution dated September 3, 2019, together with this resolution, it appearing from the records that copies of the September 3, 2019 resolution addressed to Mmes. Palacio and Tindoc both at c/o The City Election Officer, Office of the City Election Officer, Tabuco, Naga City, were returned unserved with notations on the letter-envelopes 'RTS, unknown' and 'RTS,' respectively;

(d) **NOTE** and **GRANT** the Omnibus Motion ([i] to Photocopy the Relevant Report/s on the Revision and Appreciation of Votes Relating to the Three [3] Pilot Protested Provinces of Camarines Sur, Iloilo and Negros Oriental, and [ii] to Defer the Submission of the Required Comment on the Said Report) dated October 22, 2019 filed by counsel for protestant Ferdinand 'Bongbong' R. Marcos, Jr., requesting that the protestant be allowed to photocopy the relevant report/s on the revision and appreciation of votes relating to the three (3) protested pilot provinces to enable him to comply with the directive to file his comment thereon; informing the Tribunal that protestant Marcos has designated the following individuals as his duly authorized representatives for the purpose, namely:

and requesting (i) that the Tribunal deduct from his cash deposit all the administrative expenses that will be incurred relative to his request to photocopy the relevant report/s on the revision and appreciation of votes; (ii) that protestant's representatives be accredited, authorized and allowed to witness and participate in the photocopying of the requested documents; and (iii) that the deadline for the submission of his comments on the said report/s be deferred until the requested photocopying is granted and completed;

(e) **NOTE** the Manifestation dated October 28, 2019 filed by counsel for protestee Robredo, stating that there is a great possibility that the parties will not be able to finish the viewing of the Annexes in time for the submission of the Memorandum considering the volume of documents to be viewed, hence, the urgent need for their representatives to be allowed to view and be given soft copies of the Annexes;

(f) **NOTE** the Urgent Motion for Equal Time as Protestant Marcos to File Memorandum dated October 30, 2019 filed by counsel for protestee Robredo;

(g) **ALLOW** the protestant and the protestee, through their counsels and/or above-named authorized representatives, to **VIEW, PHOTOCOPY** and **SECURE** physical or hard copies only of the Annexes to the Resolution dated October 15, 2019; and

(h) **DIRECT** the parties to **SUBMIT** their respective memoranda within twenty (20) days after completion of the requested viewing and photocopying." Reyes, A., Jr., J., on leave. Gesmundo, J., on official business. Lazaro-Javier and Inting, JJ., on official leave. (1)
